



William T. Hornaday Award

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Longs Peak Council, Boy Scouts of America

Applications must be in the Longs Peak Council, Farr Service Center, Greeley, Colorado, by December 31st in order to be considered for a scholarship at the committee's January meeting.

PURPOSE

To recognize a Boy Scout or Venturer who has earned the *William T. Hornaday Badge, Bronze Medal or Silver Medal* with a monetary scholarship to be used for his/her higher education pursuits.

REQUIREMENTS

All Applicants Must:

1. Be a registered as a youth member of the Boy Scouts of America in the Longs Peak Council.
2. Have earned a *William T. Hornaday Award* (Badge, Bronze, or Silver) in the Longs Peak Council.
3. Have maintained a school grade point average of at least grade "C".

STANDARDS

1. An individual may only receive one award.
2. Awards will be dispersed annually in \$1,000 increments to the recipient's academic institution.
3. Award recipients must remain registered members of the Boy Scouts of America while the award is being disbursed.
4. The recipient will, on an annual basis, inform the LPC Conservation Committee of his/her academic status, Scouting involvement, and current natural resources interests.
5. Award recipients will make themselves available for the purpose of promoting the *William T. Hornaday Awards* program.

AWARD AMOUNTS

The Longs Peak Council Conservation Committee may award one scholarship per year in the following amounts:

Holder of the *Hornaday Badge* may receive \$1,000 total in one \$1,000 annual disbursement.
 Holder of the *Hornaday Bronze Medal* may receive \$3,000 total in 3 \$1,000 annual disbursements.
 Holder of the *Hornaday Silver Medal* may receive \$4,000 total in 4 \$1,000 annual disbursements.
