SILVER BEAVER NOMINATION FORM INSTRUCTIONS

1. Be sure to give the full name and titles (if any) of the nominee just as you wish them to appear on the certificate. Please do not use abbreviations, initials only, or nicknames. (For example: Robert Henry Bradley; Doctor William Francis Kelly; Captain Arthur Russell Johnson; The Most Reverend Richard Joseph Brown, D.D.; Vice Admiral John Donald Morrison; The Honorable James Kerwood Ross; Ms. Mary Hartie, etc.)
2. Furnish as much information as possible for sections 6, 10, and 11. For example, Section 10: president, Libertyville Rotary Club, vestryman, St Paul's Church; chairperson Red Cross Campaign; Exalted Ruler, Elks Lodge #18; vice-president, PTA; adjutant, American Legion Post 43; medical director, Cross County Hospital; past District Deputy Grand Master, F. & A.M.; Grand Knight, Knights of Columbus Council 16, etc.
(Specific group identification enables us to provide names to national organization headquarters, who usually wish to compliment the recipient of the honor).
3. Long-established policy limits the award of the Silver Beaver to adults (over 21) who are volunteer Scouters, registered with the Boy Scouts of America.
4. Nominations will not be considered for former professional Scouters until at least five years of their leaving the profession.
5. Nominations cannot be considered for posthumous awards.

LONGS PEAK COUNCIL SILVER BEAVER COMMITTEE REQUIREMENTS

1. Complete this revised form (Rev 7/08) in its entirety and MAIL TO THE GREELEY OFFICE by the announced deadline date. (Older versions of this form and the National BSA form will not be accepted.)
2. Although there is no time requirement, nominees should have demonstrated leadership in Scouting, community, church, etc., over a sustained period of time. Usually nominees are recognized with the District Award of Merit before being nominated for the Silver Beaver. Award of Merit is not a requirement.
3. A maximum of 4-5 letters of reference is suggested. Avoid preprinted letters signed by different individuals. Try to get a good cross-section of references, i.e., Scouters, community leaders, church leaders, professional/civic organization leadership and employers. Letters should refer to the individual's personal relationship with the nominee and not hearsay.
4. Nominees should be role models in the community. Ask yourself, "If this person receives the Silver Beaver, would he/she be the most deserving among Scouters and would he/she best represent Scouting in the community?"
5. The number of Silver Beavers that can be awarded by the Council is limited. While there is no requirement to distribute the award geographically, the committee makes a genuine attempt to fairly represent all areas.
6. The Council does not attempt to present the award on a surprise basis.
7. **REMEMBER**, nominations are carried over for only one year. Applications will be returned upon request only.
